WHAT TO DO IF...

An account was opened in your name:

- Contact the account holder (i.e. bank or merchant)
- Report to local law enforcement
- Check your credit using any of the listed resources

Someone is asking you to send money:

- Verify through other means before sending funds
- Never use an email or phone number they provide
- Never allow remote access to your computer

Fraudulent charges on your credit card:

- Contact your financial institution
- · Report to your local law enforcement

Identity theft:

- Contact all known places where account(s) were opened
- Contact credit bureaus and have your credit frozen
- · Report to your local law enforcement

FREE CREDIT REPORTS CONTACT:

There are three major credit reporting agencies that compile credit reports for individuals.







How to freeze my credit:

- Call each of the major reporting agencies.
 They have one business day to freeze your credit once you have provided your personal information.
- Remember to keep the PIN and password they provide to unfreeze your credit.
