First Selectman Don Lowe called the meeting to order at 7 pm to discuss the possible purchase of the Avant 800, attachments included, for Public Works. The Selectman, along with PW Supervisor Kris Fazzone discussed the pros of purchasing the equipment. All parties agreed that the machine would accommodate all the needs of the Town and cut costs in the long run. Kris Fazzone has been gathering 3 quotes but informed that there is only one dealer that services the area. Kris Fazzone also added that he has researched other equipment but ultimately decided that the Avant would best serve the community for the best price.

The Selectman were all in agreement to bring the expense to a Town Meeting.
