- RESOLUTION NO. 1: RESOLVED: To authorize an expenditure not to exceed \$575,000 from the capital non-recurring fund for the repair and renovation of the roof at the Sherman School. Motion made by Arthur von Plachecki and seconded by Mathew Vogt. Dr Jeff Melendez, Superintendent/Principal explained the request with the help of Facilities Superintendent, Joseph Lombardozzi. After discussion the motion CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.
- RESOLUTION NO. 2: RESOLVED: To authorize an expenditure not to exceed \$33,000.00 from the capital non-recurring fund for new flooring in the Sherman ESF building. Motion made by Selectman Ostrosky and seconded by Jared Bonner. The motion was explained by First Selectman, Don Lowe, and after discussion the motion carried unanimously by a show of cards.
- RESOLUTION NO. 3: RESOLVED: To authorize an additional funding request not to exceed from the capital non-recurring fund an amount of \$13,000 to add to the previously approved \$56,000.00 from the April 14, 2021 Town Meeting, for the purchase of a new Department of Public Works truck, a 2022 Ford F-550. Motion made by Selectman Ostrosky and seconded by First Selectman Lowe. After discussion the motion CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.
- RESOLUTION NO. 4: RESOLVED: To approve an ordinance that offers tax relief for disabled Sherman Veterans. Motion was made by First Selectman Lowe and seconded by Selectmen Ostrosky and Keenan. First Selectman Lowe explained the ordinance and that it would apply to the 2022/2023 tax year. Applicants would have until December 1, 2021 to apply for this year only due to COVID. All future application dates are October 1, and under #7 the surviving spouse/child qualifications would be determined by income. After discussion the motion CARRIED unanimously by a show of cards.
