


## Q1 Would you personally be interested in this 55+ residential community for:



## Q3 What amenities would you like? (Please check all that you would like)








## Q4 When would you want to move into this proposed community?


## Q5 Are you a Sherman resident?



#### Q6 How much longer do you plan to live in Sherman?






