NARRATIVE:

On August 14th, 2023 shortly before 11:00 PM the South Burlington Police were called to a parking lot near the intersection of Williston Road and Dorset Street for a disturbance. Responding officers learned that an Uber driver had a dispute with a customer. During the dispute the customer brandished a firearm. The customer fled the area on foot and was reported to be accompanied by a female who had also been in the Uber.

Officers canvassed the area and located the couple. The male subject fled on foot while the female was detained by officers. Officers were able to recover the firearm used in the incident and identify the female. The female is considered a witness at this time.

Detectives assumed this investigation and identified the suspect as Roger Peay, 33 YOA of Burlington. Today, the Burlington Police spotted Peay and attempted to take him into custody. A foot pursuit ensued which triggered a multiagency response and the lockdown of a Burlington youth center. Peay was subsequently apprehended.

Peay was ordered held for lack of \$10,000 bail on the charge of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon. The South Burlington Police would like to acknowledge the assistance of the Burlington Police, UVM Police Services, and the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms – Burlington in resolving this case.
