Adoption of Proposed Amendments to South Burlington Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Systems Ordinance

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on Monday, August 5, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., the City Council will hold a public hearing and second reading on possible adoption of updates to the City of South Burlington Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Systems Ordinance. The hearing will be held in person and remotely via GoToMeeting. Participation options:

Following the public hearing and second reading, the City Council may take action on final passage of the updates to the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Systems Ordinance. The updates to the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Systems Ordinance contain the following components: 1) Updates to modernize definitions, language and formatting; 2) Updates to technical standards, including requirements for pump stations; 3) Defining a sewer service area within the city, establishing boundaries where connections to the municipal sewer system are allowed, required or prohibited; 4) Updates to sewer allocation fees and the fee structure, including the addition of a base rate to the fee schedule; 5) Updates to the stormwater fee calculation to align with Act 24 Chapter 101; 6) Separating the sanitary sewer and stormwater ordinance into two separate articles; 7) Removing the Credit Manual for Stormwater Fees from the code and establishing it as a resolution; and 8) Updates to the City Center Service Area, including a map that aligns with the New Town Center designation.

The proposed updates to the Sanitary Sewer and Stormwater Systems Ordinance are available for public inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 180 Market Street, and on the City website at www.southburlingtonvt.gov.
