Adoption of Proposed Amendments to South Burlington Water System Ordinance

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on Monday, August 5, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., the City Council will hold a public hearing and fourth reading on possible adoption of updates to the City of South Burlington Water System Ordinance. The hearing will be held in person and remotely via GoToMeeting. Participation options:

Following the public reading and hearing, the City Council may take action on final passage of the updates to the Water System Ordinance. The updates to the Water System Ordinance contain the following components: 1) Updates to modernize definitions, language and formatting; 2) Updates to technical standards, including requirements for remote meter reading and restrictions on booster pumps; 3) Defining a water service area within the city, establishing boundaries where connections to the municipal water system are allowed, required or prohibited; 4) Updates to water allocation fees and the fee structure, including the addition of a base rate to the fee schedule; and 5) Updates to the City Center Service Area, including a map that aligns with the New Town Center designation. 6) Updates to remove a reference to sewer billing.

The proposed updates to the Water System Ordinance are available for public inspection at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 180 Market Street, and on the City website at www.southburlingtonvt.gov.
