Public Hearing Notice

South Burlington City Council

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT the South Burlington City Council will hold a public hearing in the South Burlington City Hall, 180 Market Street, South Burlington, Vermont on Monday, December 5, at 8:30 P.M. to present information and to hear public comments concerning issuance by the City of general obligation debt and the pledging of the City's full faith and credit in support of capital improvements within the City Center Tax Increment Financing District (TIF District) and related costs.

The specific improvements expected to be constructed with the bond proceeds are City Center Park Phase II (the boardwalk connection), Garden Street (including the Williston Road intersection areas), Williston Road Streetscape (Dorset to Midas, south side), and the East-West Crossing (a walk bike bridge over I-89), all of which are within or serving the TIF District. The ballot question to be considered by the City Council, if approved, is expected to be presented for a public vote on Tuesday, March 7, 2023.
