As you begin your spring clean-up, please remember that brush may only be dropped off at the City Brush Pile Site located on Neff Road just past Oak Ridge Estates on the right. The brush site is open on the first and last Tuesdays of the month from 8:00am to 3:30pm. Brush can only be discarded during these times.

Do not drop off items not considered brush. Only items such as plant materials, tree limbs, large branches, wood items, grass clippings and trimmings or anything considered yard waste will be accepted at the Brush Site.

Spring Clean-Up

Thursday, May 7th-Saturday, May 9th, 2020 8:00am-3:30pm

For many years, the City of St. Clair has held both spring and fall clean-ups designed to help residents and property owners in St. Clair clean up and dispose of excess trash and bulk items. The city will have dumpsters available for city residents to dispose of large items.

To better serve the citizens and property owners of the City of St. Clair, we will enforce the same rules we used for our last fall clean-up. The following steps will be taken to help prevent illegal dumping and misuse of the clean-up:

- 1. All persons dropping off items at the clean-up <u>must be a</u> resident or property owner in the city limits of St. Clair.
- 2. Upon arrival at the clean-up, each person must present both a valid ID and a utility bil as proof of residency or ownership.
- 3. Staff will be present to verify these documents and verify that what is being dumped is allowed.
- 4. Cameras are installed to monitor the property any illegal dumping will be prosecuted under the law.
- 5. Ensure you arrive in time to complete all dumping by 3:30pm.
- No one will be allowed to rummage through the dumpsters to pick items out, nor will they be allowed on the property to do the same.
- 7. The dumpsters will be at the City Maintenance Shed, located at 530 Park Avenue.
- 8. As always, tires, batteries, paint, electronics, and chemicals will not be accepted. One television per household will be accepted.

The presence of items not accepted for dumping or failure to provide both the ID and proof of residency will result in the load being rejected!

UTILITY BILLING

As a reminder, the online municipal payment website and phone line are now live. You are able to access and view account details for free.

Notifications are of no cost, other than standard text message rates. To make a payment online, set up an automatic payment, or make a payment over the phone, there is a \$1.25 fee per transaction. This fee will be charged at the time of payment.

DEBRIS, WEEDS & VEGETATION

The City of St. Clair Code Enforcement Office wants the residents of St. Clair to be aware of the ordinances in place that guard against the nuisance of debris, weeds and vegetation. Debris includes, but is not limited to, weed cuttings, cut and fallen trees and shrubs, overgrown vegetation, grass or noxious weeds which are seven inches or more in height, rubbish and trash, lumber not piled or stacked 12" or more off the ground, rocks or bricks, tin, steel, parts of derelict cars or trucks, broken furniture or any flammable material which may endanger public safety. If a property is in violation, a notice will be sent to the landowner via mail & they will be given seven days to correct the condition. Please contact the Building Department/Code Enforcement Office (636-629-0333 ext. 201) with any questions pertaining to this ordinance or to report a violation. PERMITS


Permit information and a listing of required permits may be found in Chapter 6, Article II, Division 2.— Permits. in Section 6-26—Permit fees on the city's website: www.stclairmo.us. This helpful section will give examples of the calculations used for new construction and remodel permitting. Also, there is a list of required permits available in this same section. Any person who commences any work covered by this code before obtaining the necessary permits shall be subject to a 50% penalty fee of the usual permit fee in addition to the required permit fee. No person, including any carpenter or contractor, shall work on any construction job within the city for which a permit is required unless there is a permit issued for it.



MISSOURI ONE CALL

Missouri law requires that any person making or beginning any excavation must notify MOCS at least three but not more than ten working days in advance, except in the case of an emergency.
