## FALL CLEAN-UP

dumpster swaps



No covered box trailers will be allowed & we will have a separate dumpster for metal or recycling.

1. All persons dropping off items at the clean-up must be a resident or property owner in the city limits of St. Clair.
2. Upon arrival at the clean-up, each person must present both a valid ID and a verified permit from city hall as proof of residency or ownership, to make sure all collections are paid/up to date.
3. Staff will be present to verify these documents and verify that what is being dumped is allowed.
4. Cameras are installed to monitor the property – any illegal dumping will be prosecuted under the law.
5. Ensure you arrive in time to complete all dumping by 3:30pm.
6. No one will be allowed to rummage through the dumpsters.
7. The dumpsters will be at the City Maintenance Shed, located at 530 Park Avenue.
8. As always, tires, batteries, paint, electronics, and chemicals will not be accepted. One television per household will be accepted.

TRICK OR TREAT WILL TAKE PLACE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 5:00-8:00 PM ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31ST. PLEASE LIGHT THE ENTRANCE TO YOUR HOME IF YOU PLAN TO PARTICIPATE BY DISTRIBUTING GOODIES. TRY TO HAVE YOUR CHILD WEAR SOMETHING REFLECTIVE. THE POLICE & FIRE DEPARTMENTS WILL BE PATROLLING THE STREETS.

• We accept any form of payment. If you pay with a Credit/Debit card, there is a transaction fee of \$2.50 minimum or 3% of the bill.



### WINTER Driving TIPS

- Drive Slowly**  
Reduce your speed in snowy road conditions to avoid accidents and skidding.
- Avoid Distractions**  
When driving, give your full attention to the road. Avoid using your cell phone or eating.
- Avoid Cruise Control**  
Always be in control of when it comes to acceleration and deceleration in snowy conditions.
- Plan Your Route**  
Bridges and cooler areas can have more ice than others. Stay clear.
- Check Your Tires**  
Make sure that your tires have good traction when driving in snowy conditions.
- Increase Distance**  
Increasing the distance will give you enough time to slow down if you lose control of your vehicle.

## Put a FREEZE on Winter Fires

**Did you know?** 1 in every 7 home fires and 1 in every 5 home fire deaths involves heating equipment.

**As you stay cozy and warm this winter, stay fire smart!** Have a qualified professional clean and inspect your chimney and vents **every year**.

Store cooled ashes in a tightly covered metal container and keep it **outside at least 10 feet** from your home and any nearby buildings.

## Put a FREEZE on Winter Fires

**Did you know?** Half of all home heating fires occur in December, January and February.

**As you stay cozy and warm this winter, stay fire smart!** Plug only **1 heat-producing appliance** (like a space heater) into an electrical outlet at a time.

Keep anything that can burn **at least 3 feet** from any heat source.

SEC. 24-63. - RECONNECTION PROCEDURES.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL A RECONNECTION OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES BE PROVIDED AFTER NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS (MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY 8:00 A.M. — 4:30 P.M.), UNLESS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR.
