1. All persons dropping off items at the clean-up must be a resident or property owner in the city limits of St. Clair.
2. Upon arrival at the clean-up, each person MUST PRESENT A VERIFIED PERMIT FROM CITY HALL saying you are up to date on all fees with the city.
3. You will need to come/call/email city hall for this document – Monday-Friday 8:00am-4:30pm citycollector@stclairmo.us
4. Staff will be present to verify these documents and verify that what is being dumped is allowed.
5. Cameras are installed to monitor the property – any illegal dumping will be prosecuted under the law.
6. Ensure you arrive in time to complete all dumping by 3:30pm.
7. No one will be allowed to rummage through the dumpsters to pick items out, nor will they be allowed on the property to do the same.
8. The dumpsters will be at the city maintenance shed, located at 530 Park Avenue.
9. As always, tires, batteries, paint, electronics, and chemicals will not be accepted. One television per household will be accepted.
10. No covered box trailers will be allowed & we will have a separate dumpster for metal or recycling.

Pool Permit Requirements

for all PERMANENT pools over 24" deep.

- Must submit a site plan drawing along with application and payment of the \$45 Pool Permit Fee.
- Must be in a fenced in area. (Must get a fence permit if a new fence is needed)
- Must get an Electrical Permit (if new electrical lines are needed to be run)
- Must get a Final Inspection completed by The City Inspector prior to first use.

Requirements for a Fence Permit

- ✓ set back 2-9" from the property line
- ✓ 8 feet or less in height
- ✓ Constructed of wood, masonry, vinyl, or chain link materials
- ✓ must be kept in good condition at all times
- ✓ cannot fence in a front yard
- ✓ Contractors must be licensed with the city
- ✓ Include a drawing showing fence placement and property lines
- ✓ Pay a Permit Fee of \$45 with application

LICENSED

Contractors are required to have a license if doing business in city limits

All businesses in the City limits are required to have a license.

The cost for a Business License is \$50.00 with the exception of salons, barber shops and insurance offices which are \$25.00.

Prorated Rates for New Businesses.

Feb-April	\$50.00
May-July	\$37.50
August-Oct	\$25.00
Nov-January	\$12.50

DID YOU KNOW

The City of St. Clair has a few rules in regards to keeping vehicles on your property!

1. Any unlicensed vehicle can not be parked or stored on any residential property other than in completely enclosed buildings.
2. Major repairs or dismantling can not be made to any vehicle upon a public street or upon private property unless it is conducted in a completely enclosed area.
3. The vehicle receiving repairs or dismantling must be owned by a resident of the property it is being worked on.
4. Minor repairs may be performed in an enclosed area or, if performed outside, must be completed within 8 hours.

SUMMER MEANS LAWN CARE

Help us keep the City of St. Clair Beautiful!!!

all lawns must be kept well maintained at 7 inches or shorter in height. Lawn clippings must be bagged up or blown back into yard. Blowing your excess lawn clippings into the road is ILLEGAL. These clippings can end up in storm drains, causing build-up and drainage issues or even localized flooding. Additionally, tires struggle to stop as easily on grass clippings, especially so on motorcycles. When a motorcycle hits grass clippings, it's like ice.
