A public hearing will be held at 6:50 p.m. on Monday, August 15, 2016, before the Board of Alderman meeting at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, 1 Paul Parks Drive, St. Clair, MO at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax rate to be set by the City of St. Clair, a political subdivision. The tax rate shall be set subject to change, based on the State Auditor's approval, to produce revenues which the budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016, shows to be required from the property tax. The tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of revenue by the current assessed valuation. The result is multiplied by 100 as the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100 valuation.
