

## **Police Department**

### **August 2021 Monthly Report**

During August 2021, the police department responded to 1,137 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,149 Calls for Service responded to in August of 2020. This is a 1 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of August 2021 was 8,331 that is 320 calls less than 8,651, experienced at the end of August 2020 or 4 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 17 traffic crashes during the month of August, which represents a 42 percent increase over the 12 responded to in August of 2020. Officers issued 81 total citations during August 2021, which shows 12 percent decrease over the 92 that were issued in August 2020. Officers arrested 8 drivers on DUI charges during August 2021 which is a 167 percent increase over the 3 DUI's in August 2020.

Among the criminal offenses reported there were 4 assaults, 13 burglaries, 2 drug investigations, 0 forgeries, 3 motor vehicle thefts, 4 sex offenses, 29 thefts and 9 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in August of 2021 was \$110,476.47, which is a 55 percent increase over the \$71,457 stolen in August of 2020. \$33,276.00 was recovered in August of 2021, which is a 89 percent increase over the \$17,587 recovered in August of 2020. Officers arrested 81 adults and 0 juveniles, for a total of 81 arrests in August 2021. This is 2 less arrests or a 2 percent decrease over the total 83 made in August 2020.

In August 2021 the Youth Services Division received 17 youth referrals (3 males and 14 females). Of those 17 youth referrals, 16 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 1 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 64 calls at local liquor establishments in August 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations. 144 calls were reported in August 2020, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

Sergeant Grant and K9 Officer Glock completed 5.00 hours of training in August 2021. There were 0 canine deployments with Sergeant Grant seen in August 2021.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 213.25 hours of training during the month of August in 2021, and 2,398.85 hours of training year to date.
