November 2021 Monthly Report

During November 2021, the police department responded to 926 Calls for Service, compared to the 955 Calls for Service responded to in November of 2020. This is a 3 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of November 2021 was 11,361 that is 455 calls less than 11,861, experienced at the end of November 2020 or 4 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 13 traffic crashes during the month of November, which represents a 35 percent decrease over the 20 responded to in November of 2020. Officers issued 91 total citations during November 2021, which shows 4 percent decrease over the 95 that were issued in November 2020. Officers arrested 8 drivers on DUI charges during November 2021 which is a 60 percent increase over the 5 DUI's in November 2020.

Among the criminal offenses reported there were 2 assaults, 5 burglaries, 2 drug investigations, 0 forgeries, 1 motor vehicle thefts, 6 sex offenses, 27 thefts and 3 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in November of 2021 was \$59,503, which is a 58 percent decrease over the \$140,798 stolen in November of 2020. \$4,659 was recovered in November of 2021, which is a 93 percent decrease over the \$64,313 recovered in November of 2020. Officers arrested 76 adults and 9 juveniles, for a total of 85 arrests in November 2021. This is 23 more arrests or a 37 percent increase over the total 62 made in November 2020.

In November 2021 the Youth Services Division received 21 youth referrals (9 males and 12 females). Of those 21 youth referrals, 21 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 71 calls at local liquor establishments in November 2021, 0 of which was a liquor code violation. 105 calls were reported in November 2020, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock completed 13 hours of training with 2 call outs in the month of November. While K9 Vader completed 8.55 hours of training with 5 call outs in the month of November.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 283.50 hours of training during the month of November in 2021, and 3,413.95 hours of training year to date.
