September 2021 Monthly Report

During September 2021, the police department responded to 1,043 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,173 Calls for Service responded to in September of 2020. This is an 11 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of September 2021 was 9,374 that is 450 calls less than 9,824, experienced at the end of September 2020 or 5 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 11 traffic crashes during the month of September, which represents a 27 percent decrease over the 15 responded to in September of 2020. Officers issued 88 total citations during September 2021, which shows 22 percent decrease over the 113 that were issued in September 2020. Officers arrested 4 drivers on DUI charges during September 2021 which is a 100 percent increase over the 2 DUI's in September 2020.

Among the criminal offenses reported there were 7 assaults, 10 burglaries, 2 drug investigations, 0 forgeries, 5 motor vehicle thefts, 10 sex offenses, 26 thefts and 7 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in September of 2021 was \$182,816.24, which is a 533 percent increase over the \$28,896 stolen in September of 2020. Of note, we had 5 motor vehicle thefts this month, which accounted for \$111,000.00 of the \$182,816.24 total reported stolen property value. \$86,096.06 was recovered in September of 2021, which is an 1,771 percent increase over the \$4,601 recovered in September of 2020. Three of the previously mentioned automobiles that were stolen in September were recovered, accounting for \$80,000.00 of the \$86,096.06 total recovered property value reported. Officers arrested 81 adults and 0 juveniles, for a total of 81 arrests in September 2021. This is 10 less arrests or a 11 percent decrease over the total 91 made in September 2020.

In September 2021 the Youth Services Division received 17 youth referrals (7 males and 10 females). Of those 17 youth referrals, 14 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 3 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 64 calls at local liquor establishments in September 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations. 129 calls were reported in September 2020, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

This month K9 Officer Glock transitioned handlers from Sgt Grant to K9 Officer Chariter. During this period Sgt Grant and Officer Chartier worked together on multiple areas of training with K9 Glock to insure a smooth transition. K9 Glock completed 7 hours of training during the month of September with 0 call outs. We will also be adding a second K9 Officer to our team with Cpl Sherwood as the handler in October.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 271.00 hours of training during the month of September in 2021, and 2,669.85 hours of training year to date.
