RESOLUTION NO. 4-1-23, SERIES OF 2023 – A RESOLUTION BEFORE THE CITY OF STERLING, LOGAN COUNTY, COLORADO, IN OPPOSITION TO STATEWIDE LAND USE AND ZONING PREEMPTIONS IN SENATE BILL 23-213:

City Manager Blankenship advised Council this Resolution states the City's opposition to Colorado Senate Bill 23-213, which would place statewide mandates on hyper local land use matters and substitute the judgment of legislators and state regulators who lack the understanding needed to make the right decisions for our community. It also authorizes the Mayor to sign a letter to the Colorado General Assembly expressing the City's opposition and urging its legislators to vote NO on SB 23-213.

Councilmember Janes made a motion to approve Resolution No. 4-1-23, Series of 2023. Councilmember Angell seconded the motion.

Mayor Desormeaux advised this Resolution is what had been discussed at the previous Council meeting. Thursday there will be public input and letters can be sent to Legislatures.


By a five-yes vote, the motion was approved.
