AUGUST 2022 MONTHLY REPORT

During August 2022, the police department responded to 1094 Calls for Service, compared to the 1137 Calls for Service responded to in August of 2021 indicating a 4 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of August 2022 were 7681 which is 647 less calls than 8328 at the end of August 2021, which is an 8 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 10 traffic crashes during the month of August 2022, which represents a 41 percent decrease over the 17 responses in August of 2021. Officers issued 114 total citations during August 2022, which shows 40 percent increase over the 81 that were issued in August 2021. Officers arrested 6 drivers on DUI charges during August 2022 which represents a 25 percent decrease over the 8 DUI's in August 2021.

There were 140 criminal offenses investigated in August 2022, which is a 20 percent decrease when compared to the 174 criminal offenses investigated in August 2022. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 2 sexual assaults, 23 assaults, 0 arson, 6 burglaries, 33 thefts, 3 motor vehicle theft, 2 forgeries, 0 fraud, 18 vandalisms, 10 drug investigations, 4 weapons violations, 3 disturbances, 12 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 13 trespasses. The value of property stolen in August of 2022 was \$35,895, which is a 68 percent decrease from the \$110,476 stolen in August of 2021. \$6,833 was recovered in August of 2022, which is a 79 percent decrease over the \$33,276 recovered in August of 2021. Officers arrested 75 adults and 2 juveniles, for a total of 77 arrests in August 2022. This is 4 less arrests or a 5 percent decrease over the total 81 made in August 2021.

In August 2022, the Youth Services Division received 2 youth referrals (2 males and 0 females). Of those 2 youth referrals, 2 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 63 calls at local liquor establishments in August 2022, 0 of were a liquor code violation. With 64 calls were reported in August 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock has been phased out of active duty, as he will be retiring in the coming months. While K9 Vader completed 8 hours of training with no call outs in the month of August. K9 monthly training is temporarily out of service as the K9 handler is on light duty.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 276 hours of training during the month of August in 2022.
