RESOLUTION NO. 8-8-21, SERIES OF 2021 – A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO CANCEL THE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 ELECTION FOR MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS:

City Manager Saling advised Council the Colorado Revised Statutes 1-5-208(1.5) specifies that if the only matter before the electorate in a nonpartisan election is the election of persons to office, and if, at the close of business on the 63rd day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the election, including candidates filling affidavits of intent, the designated election official, if instructed by resolution of the governing body, shall cancel the election and declare the candidates elected. There are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the November 2, 2021 election. This Resolution directs the City Clerk to cancel the election and declare those parties having submitted petitions for the vacant offices elected.

Councilmember Anderson made a motion to approve Resolution No. 8-8-21, Series of 2021. Councilmember McCarty seconded the motion. By a five-yes vote, the motion was approved.


Councilmember Desormeaux arrived at this time.
