NEW BUSINESS:

RESOLUTION NO. 12-1-20, SERIES OF 2020 – A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 11-1-19, SERIES OF 2019; AND ADOPTING A NEW CHARGES AND FEES POLICY; AND ESTABLISHING NEW CHARGES AND FEES AS REQUIRED IN NUMEROUS SECTIONS OF THE STERLING CITY CODE, AS SET FORTH HEREIN; AND USER CHARGES AND FEES NOT REQUIRED TO BE SET BY SPECIFIC SECTIONS OF THE STERLING CITY CODE;

City Manager Saling advised Council this Resolution repeals Resolution No. 11-1-19, Series of 2019, and makes revisions to charges and fees of the City. Revisions have been made in Section I, Police Department (addition of some fees and increase in some fees, including by statute).

Councilmember Janes made a motion to approve Resolution No. 12-1-20, Series of 2020. Councilmember Ritter seconded the motion. By a seven-yes vote, the motion was approved.

RESOLUTION NO. 12-2-20, SERIES OF 2020 - A RESOLUTION BEFORE THE CITY OF STERLING, LOGAN COUNTY, COLORADO APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES WITH THE LOGAN COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY;

City Manager Saling advised Council this Resolution approves a new Agreement with the Logan County Humane Society for animal control services. The new Agreement is for the term commencing on January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2021. The Agreement provides for payment to the Logan County Humane Society of \$176,821 for the one-year term of the Agreement.

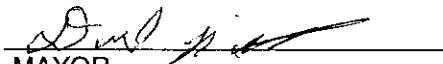
