

## **POLICE DEPARTMENT**

### **FEBRUARY 2020 MONTHLY REPORT**

During February 2020, the police department responded to 1,143 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,014 Calls for Service responded to in February of 2019. This is a 13 percent increase. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of February 2020 was 2,343 which is 265 calls more than the 2,078 experienced at the end of February 2019 or 13 percent increase.

Officers responded to 19 traffic accidents during the month of February, which represents a 12 percent increase over the 17 responded to in February of 2019. Officers issued 29 penalty assessments during February 2020, which shows 53 percent increase over the 19 that were issued in February 2019. Officers issued 209 warnings in February which was a 11 percent increase over last year's 188. Officers arrested 3 drivers on DUI charges during February 2020 which is 100 percent increase over the 0 DUI's in February 2019.

Among the criminal offenses reported there was 1 assault, 8 burglaries, 10 drug investigations, 22 forgeries, 5 motor vehicle thefts, 7 sex offenses, 49 thefts and 9 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in February of 2020 was \$60,549.00, which is a 10 percent decrease over the, \$67,317.00 stolen in February of 2019. \$14,943.00 was recovered in February of 2020, which is a 63 percent decrease over the \$39,950.00 recovered in February of 2019. Officers arrested 83 adults and 7 juveniles, for a total of 90 arrests in February 2020. This is 29 more arrests or 47 percent increase over the total 61 made in February 2019.

In February 2020 the Youth Services Division received 21 youth referrals (13 males and 8 female). Of those 21 youth referrals, 21 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 received from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court.

Officers responded to 144 calls at local liquor establishments in February 2020, with 99 calls being reported in February 2019.

Corporal Grant and K9 Officer Glock completed 9.42 hours of training in February 2020. There were 0 canine deployments with Corporal Grant seen in February 2020.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 97.76 hours of training during the month of February in 2020 and 146.23 hours of training for the year 2019 at the end of February.
