February 2022 Monthly Report

During February 2022, the police department responded to 852 Calls for Service, compared to the 776 Calls for Service responded to in February of 2021 indicating a 9.8 percent increase.

Officers responded to 16 traffic crashes during the month of February, which represents a 14 percent increase over the 14 responded to in February of 2021. Officers issued 80 total citations during February 2022, which shows 3 percent increase over the 78 that were issued in February 2021. Officers arrested 5 drivers on DUI charges during February 2022 which is a 400 percent increase over the 1 DUI in February 2021.

There were 93 Criminal Offenses investigated in February 2022, which is a 29 percent decrease when compared to the 131 criminal offenses investigated in February 2021. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 2 sex offenses, 6 assaults, 7 burglaries, 29 thefts, 1 motor vehicle theft, 1 forgery, 7 frauds, 13 vandalisms, 8 drug investigations, 6 weapons violations, 1 disturbance, 6 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 6 trespasses. The value of property stolen in February of 2022 was \$22,386, which is a 70 percent increase over the \$13,199 stolen in February of 2021. \$3,047 was recovered in February of 2022, which is a 67 percent decrease over the \$9,273 recovered in February of 2021. Officers arrested 51 adults and 4 juveniles, for a total of 55 arrests in February 2022. This is 26 less arrests or a 32 percent decrease over the total 81 made in February 2021.

In February 2022, the Youth Services Division received 7 youth referrals (4 males and 3 females). Of those 7 youth referrals, 7 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 36 calls at local liquor establishments in February 2022, 0 of which was a liquor code violation. 119 calls were reported in February 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock completed 19 hours of training with 1 call out in the month of February. While K9 Vader completed 13.1 hours of training with 7 call outs in the month of February.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 96 hours of training during the month of February in 2022.
