

POLICE DEPARTMENT JUNE 2022 MONTHLY REPORT

During June 2022, the police department responded to 820 Calls for Service, compared to the 1209 Calls for Service responded to in June of 2021 indicating a 32 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of June 2022 were 5509 which is 545 less calls than 5964 at the end of May 2021, which is an 8 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 19 traffic crashes during the month of June, which represents a 10 percent decrease over the 21 responded to in June of 2021. Officers issued 90 total citations during June 2022, which shows 22 percent decrease over the 115 that were issued in June 2021. Officers arrested 1 driver on DUI charges during June 2022 which represents a 67 percent decrease over the 3 DUI's in June 2021.

There were 124 criminal offenses investigated in June 2022, which is a 22 percent decrease when compared to the 159 criminal offenses investigated in June 2021. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 9 sexual assaults, 16 assaults, 5 burglaries, 27 thefts, 5 motor vehicle theft, 0 forgeries, 1 fraud, 15 vandalisms, 7 drug investigations, 6 weapons violations, 5 disturbances, 9 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 13 trespasses. The value of property stolen in June of 2022 was \$337,046, which is a 75 percent increase from the \$85,294 stolen in June of 2021. \$311,198 was recovered in June of 2022, which is an 87 percent increase over the \$39,241 recovered in June of 2021. Officers arrested 67 adults and 6 juveniles, for a total of 73 arrests in June 2022. This is 41 less arrests or a 36 percent decrease over the total 114 made in June 2021.

In June 2022, the Youth Services Division received 7 youth referrals (4 males and 3 females). Of those 7 youth referrals, 6 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 1 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 43 calls at local liquor establishments in June 2022, 0 of were a liquor code violation. With 116 calls were reported in June 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock has been phased out of active duty, as he will be retiring in the coming months. While K9 Vader completed 17 hours of training with no call outs in the month of June.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 137.5 hours of training during the month of June in 2022.
