

Police Department January 2020 Monthly Report

During January 2020, the police department responded to 1,200 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,064 Calls for Service responded to in January of 2019. This is a 13 percent increase. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of January 2020 was 1,200 which is 136 calls more than the 1,064 experienced at the end of January 2019 or 13 percent increase.

Officers responded to 22 traffic accidents during the month of January, which represents a 22 percent increase over the 18 responded to in January of 2019. Officers issued 27 penalty assessments during January 2020, which shows 50 percent increase over the 18 that were issued in January 2019. Officers issued 162 warnings in January which was a 45 percent increase over last year's 112. Officers arrested 1 driver on DUI charges during January 2020 which is 75 percent decrease over the 4 DUI's in January 2019.

Among the criminal offenses reported there were 7 assaults, 6 burglaries, 11 drug investigations, 12 forgeries, 9 motor vehicle thefts, 12 sex offenses, 37 thefts and 14 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in January of 2020 was \$19,665.35, which is an 81 percent decrease over the \$102,030 stolen in January of 2019. \$60,636 was recovered in January of 2019, which is an 89 percent decrease over the \$6,924 recovered in January of 2020. Officers arrested 76 adults and 6 juveniles, for a total of 82 arrests in January 2020. This is 0 more arrests or 0 percent over the total 82 made in January 2019.

In January 2020 the Youth Services Division received 17 youth referrals (8 males and 9 female). Of those 17 youth referrals, 16 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 received from the parent, 1 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court.

Officers responded to 108 calls at local liquor establishments in January 2020, with 94 calls being reported in January 2019.

Corporal Grant and K9 Officer Glock completed 7.02 hours of training in January 2020. There were 0 canine deployments with Corporal Grant seen in January 2020.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 80.72 hours of training during the month of January in 2020 and 80.72 hours of training for the year 2019 at the end of January.
