

## **Police Department**

### **January 2022 Monthly Report**

During January 2022, the police department responded to 909 Calls for Service, compared to the 912 Calls for Service responded to in January of 2021.

Officers responded to 10 traffic crashes during the month of January, which represents a 38 percent decrease over the 16 responded to in January of 2021. Officers issued 70 total citations during January 2022, which shows 15 percent decrease over the 82 that were issued in January 2021. Officers arrested 6 drivers on DUI charges during January 2022 which is a 200 percent increase over the 2 DUI's in January 2021.

There were 107 Criminal Offenses investigated in January 2022, which is a 32 percent decrease when compared to the 157 criminal offenses investigated in January 2021. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 3 sex offenses, 1 robbery, 12 assaults, 5 burglaries, 21 thefts, 3 motor vehicle thefts, 1 forgery, 4 frauds, 14 vandalisms, 7 drug investigations, 8 weapons violations, 3 disturbances, 12 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 13 trespasses. The value of property stolen in January of 2022 was \$145,902.46, which is a 67 percent increase over the \$87,304 stolen in January of 2021. \$109,895 was recovered in January of 2022, which is a 119 percent increase over the \$50,086 recovered in January of 2021. Officers arrested 66 adults and 2 juveniles, for a total of 68 arrests in January 2022. This is 9 more arrests or a 10.3 percent increase over the total 75 made in January 2021.

In January 2022, the Youth Services Division received 5 youth referrals (5 males and 0 females). Of those 5 youth referrals, 5 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 40 calls at local liquor establishments in January 2022, 0 of which was a liquor code violation. 88 calls were reported in January 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock completed 16.17 hours of training with 0 call outs in the month of January. While K9 Vader completed 12.92 hours of training with 5 call outs in the month of January.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 91 hours of training during the month of January in 2022.
