

POLICE DEPARTMENT JULY 2022 MONTHLY REPORT

During July 2022, the police department responded to 1078 Calls for Service, compared to the 1227 Calls for Service responded to in July of 2021 indicating a 12 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of July 2022 were 6587 which is 604 less calls than 7191 at the end of July 2021, which is an 8 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 37 traffic crashes during the month of July, which represents an 85 percent increase over the 20 responded to in July of 2021. Officers issued 112 total citations during July 2022, which shows 8 percent increase over the 104 that were issued in July 2021. Officers arrested 2 drivers on DUI charges during July 2022 which represents a 78 percent decrease over the 9 DUI's in July 2021.

There were 122 criminal offenses investigated in July 2022, which is a 37 percent decrease when compared to the 194 criminal offenses investigated in July 2021. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 0 sexual assaults, 15 assaults, 2 arson, 8 burglaries, 32 thefts, 2 motor vehicle theft, 2 forgeries, 5 fraud, 10 vandalisms, 8 drug investigations, 2 weapons violations, 7 disturbances, 7 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 16 trespasses. The value of property stolen in July of 2022 was \$258,582, which is a 1,155 percent increase from the \$20,602 stolen in July of 2021. \$57,685 was recovered in July of 2022, which is an 822 percent increase over the \$6,254 recovered in July of 2021. Officers arrested 76 adults and 2 juveniles, for a total of 78 arrests in July 2022. This is 18 less arrests or a 19 percent decrease over the total 96 made in July 2021.

In July 2022, the Youth Services Division received 2 youth referrals (1 males and 1 females). Of those 2 youth referrals, 2 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 82 calls at local liquor establishments in July 2022, 0 of were a liquor code violation. With 80 calls were reported in July 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock has been phased out of active duty, as he will be retiring in the coming months. While K9 Vader completed 13 hours of training with no call outs in the month of July.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 20.5 hours of training during the month of July in 2022.

*The significant increased amount of property stolen in July 2022 was due to a case in which an elderly person was a victim of insurance fraud/theft from a family member, which amounts to approximately to \$185,000.
