JUNE 2020 MONTHLY REPORT

During June 2020, the police department responded to 1123 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,229 Calls for Service responded to in June of 2019. This is a 9 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of June 2020 was 6,396 which is 641 calls less than the 7,037 experienced at the end of June 2019 or 9 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 11 traffic accidents during the month of June, which represents a 39 percent decrease over the 18 responded to in June of 2019. Officers issued 13 penalty assessments during June 2020, which shows 48 percent decrease over the 52 that were issued in June 2019. Officers issued 0 warnings in June which was a 100 percent decrease over last year's 142. Officers arrested 2 drivers on DUI charges during June 2020 which is 50 percent decrease over the 4 DUI's in June 2019.

Among the criminal offenses reported there were 9 assaults, 10 burglaries, 9 drug investigations, 18 forgeries, 4 motor vehicle thefts, 8 sex offenses, 42 thefts and 13 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in June of 2020 was \$119,006.03, which is a 7 percent increase over the, \$111,384.00 stolen in June of 2019. \$52,530.00 was recovered in June of 2020, which is a 5095 percent increase over the \$1,011.00 recovered in June of 2019. Officers arrested 87 adults and 5 juveniles, for a total of 92 arrests in June 2020. This is 7 more arrests or 8.23 percent increase over the total 85 made in June 2019.

In June 2020 the Youth Services Division received 18 youth referrals (8 males and 10 female). Of those 18 youth referrals, 18 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 received from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court.

Officers responded to 105 calls at local liquor establishments in June 2020, with 115 calls being reported in June 2019.

Corporal Grant and K9 Officer Glock completed 7.00 hours of training in June 2020. There were 0 canine deployments with Corporal Grant seen in June 2020.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 208.35 hours of training during the month of June in 2020 and 748.67 hours of training for the year 2020 at the end of June.

April 2020, was the first full month of the COVID-19 pandemic, which included all the state-wide, local, and the Sterling Police Department's directives, orders, procedures and protocols that changed our normal operations during this unprecedented time. The pandemic has changed our numbers and are skewed from normal averages as a result. Overall call load was down which was anticipated as people will be reporting certain crimes/incidents less and are out and about less meaning less traffic accidents, etc., however, some types of calls have increased such as motor vehicle thefts, thefts, Disturbances and others. In addition, while we still respond to all in progress calls, emergency calls, 911 calls, etc. other calls are taken over the phone or online. While the officers are as visible in our community as ever before during the COVID-19 pandemic, proactive calls such as traffic have been reduced in order to protect our officers so it does not spread throughout our agency limiting our ability to provide the necessary emergency response to our citizens.

Public safety remains our top priority and we are balancing all the necessary precautions, protocols and procedures with providing the absolutely critical services to our community that they have come to expect.
