A SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING IS CALLED FOR INTERVIEWS WITH APPLICANTS FOR THE CITY COUNCIL VACANCY OF WARD 3:

Mayor Torres advised Council the purpose of the special meeting is to interview applicants for the City Council vacancy of Ward 3. The process will be to interview each applicant one at a time. There will then be discussion and a vote taken. The questions asked were as follows:

1. What is the single most important skill you have that you would exhibit?
2. If you could change something in the City of Sterling, what would it be?
3. What do you know about Robert's Rules of Order and what committees were you on that used them?
4. How do you solve conflict with people with different views?
5. Why do you want to become a City Councilmember?
6. Would you find it difficult to vote in public on a controversial issue?
7. Are you related by blood or marriage to any Councilmember?
8. Do you feel that you have the time to devote to this position?
9. Do you have the support of your family members?
10. In making decisions, do you rely on your personal beliefs or do you prefer to do research?
11. Do you think that authority should be delegated or are you a take charge person?
12. If you are selected to the Council, would you serve on one of the city's advisory boards?


Those interviewed were Ms. Kelly Blecha and Mr. Luke Janes.

Council then did a paper vote noting their first choice and second choice. First place was awarded five points per vote and second choice was awarded three points. City Attorney Penny and City Manager Saling tallied the votes. Luke Janes – 30, and Kelly Blecha – 18.


