Mayor Appelhans made a motion to go into executive session for discussion of a personnel matter under C.R.S. Section 24-6-402 (4)(f) and not involving; any specific employees who have requested discussion of the matter in open session; any member of this body or any elected official; the appointment of any person to fill an office of this body or of an elected official; or personnel policies that do not require the discussion of matters personal to particular employees. Councilmember Desormeaux seconded the motion. By a seven-yes vote, the motion was approved.

Council went into executive session at 5:18 p.m.

Council came out of executive session at 6:16 p.m.

Mayor Appelhans advised the participants in the executive session were: City Council, City Manager, City Attorney, Deputy City Attorney and Human Resource Director. For the record, if any person who participated in the executive session believes that any substantial discussion of any matters not included in the motion to go into the executive session occurred during the executive session, or that any improper action occurred during the executive session in violation of the Open Meetings Law, he asked that they state their concerns for the record.


