

Police Department March 2020 Monthly Report

During March 2020, the police department responded to 1,143 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,239 Calls for Service responded to in March of 2019. This is a 9 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of March 2020 was 2,343 which is 265 calls more than the 2,078 experienced at the end of March 2019 or 13 percent increase.

Officers responded to 14 traffic accidents during the month of March, which represents a 26 percent decrease over the 19 responded to in March of 2019. Officers issued 17 penalty assessments during March 2020, which shows 48 percent decrease over the 33 that were issued in March 2019. Officers issued 94 warnings in March which was a 68 percent decrease over last year's 294. Officers arrested 6 drivers on DUI charges during March 2020 which is 200 percent increase over the 2 DUI's in March 2019.

Among the criminal offenses reported there was 3 assault, 7 burglaries, 8 drug investigations, 17 forgeries, 12 motor vehicle thefts, 3 sex offenses, 48 thefts and 10 vandalisms. The value of property stolen in March of 2020 was \$124,773.66, which is a 103 percent increase over the, \$61,372 stolen in March of 2019. \$112,589.88 was recovered in March of 2020, which is a 140 percent increase over the \$46,940 recovered in March of 2019. Officers arrested 74 adults and 1 juvenile, for a total of 75 arrests in March 2020. This is 4 more arrests or 5.63 percent increase over the total 71 made in March 2019.

In March 2020 the Youth Services Division received 20 youth referrals (12 males and 8 female). Of those 20 youth referrals, 17 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 received from the parent, 0 received from school, 3 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court.

Officers responded to 157 calls at local liquor establishments in March 2020, with 130 calls being reported in March 2019.

Corporal Grant and K9 Officer Glock completed 2.00 hours of training in March 2020. There were 6 canine deployments with Corporal Grant seen in March 2020.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 141.36 hours of training during the month of March in 2020 and 685.47 hours of training for the year 2019 at the end of March.
