

## **POLICE DEPARTMENT MARCH 2022 MONTHLY REPORT**

During March 2022, the police department responded to 1,084 Calls for Service, compared to the 983 Calls for Service responded to in March of 2021 indicating a 10 percent increase.

Officers responded to 9 traffic crashes during the month of March, which represents a 63 percent decrease over the 24 responded to in March of 2021. Officers issued 115 total citations during March 2022, which shows 11 percent increase over the 104 that were issued in March 2021. Officers arrested 4 drivers on DUI charges during March 2022 which is a 20 percent decrease over the 5 DUI's in March 2021.

There were 93 criminal offenses investigated in March 2022, which is a 28 percent decrease when compared to the 130 criminal offenses investigated in March 2021. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 2 sex offenses, 12 assaults, 5 burglaries, 25 thefts, 2 motor vehicle thefts, 3 forgeries, 1 fraud, 6 vandalisms, 13 drug investigations, 1 weapons violation, 4 disturbances, 10 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 9 trespasses. The value of property stolen in March of 2022 was \$14,003, which is a 18 percent decrease from the \$17,089 stolen in March of 2021. \$22,010 was recovered in March of 2022, which is a 188 percent increase over the \$7,654 recovered in March of 2021. Officers arrested 64 adults and 7 juveniles, for a total of 71 arrests in March 2022. This is 10 less arrests or a 12 percent decrease over the total 81 made in March 2021.

In March 2022, the Youth Services Division received 9 youth referrals (6 males and 3 females). Of those 9 youth referrals, 9 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 67 calls at local liquor establishments in March 2022, 0 of which was a liquor code violation. 132 calls were reported in March 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock completed 1.33 hours of training with 1 call out in the month of March. While K9 Vader completed 35.75 hours of training with no call outs in the month of March.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 196 hours of training during the month of March in 2022.
