

POLICE DEPARTMENT MAY 2022 MONTHLY REPORT

During May 2022, the police department responded to 867 Calls for Service, compared to the 1,065 Calls for Service responded to in May of 2021 indicating a 19 percent decrease. The year-to-date calls for service at the end of May 2022 were 4,689 which is 66 less calls than 4,755 at the end of May 2021, which is a 1.40 percent decrease.

Officers responded to 13 traffic crashes during the month of May, which represents a 55 percent decrease over the 29 responded to in May of 2021. Officers issued 68 total citations during May 2022, which shows 38 percent decrease over the 109 that were issued in May 2021. Officers arrested 3 drivers on DUI charges during May 2022 which represents a 50 percent decrease over the 6 DUI's in May 2021.

There were 84 criminal offenses investigated in May 2022, which is a 45 percent decrease when compared to the 152 criminal offenses investigated in May 2021. Among the criminal offenses investigated there were 0 sexual assaults, 14 assaults, 5 burglaries, 26 thefts, 4 motor vehicle theft, 0 forgeries, 1 fraud, 11 vandalisms, 5 drug investigations, 1 weapons violations, 0 disturbances, 10 family offenses (to include domestic violence and child abuse) and 6 trespasses. The value of property stolen in May of 2022 was \$290,816, which is a 438 percent increase from the \$54,083 stolen in May of 2021. \$31,326 was recovered in May of 2022, which is a 318 percent increase over the \$7,495 recovered in May of 2021. Officers arrested 50 adults and 3 juveniles, for a total of 53 arrests in May 2022. This is 38 less arrests or a 42 percent decrease over the total 91 made in May 2021.

In May 2022, the Youth Services Division received 6 youth referrals (2 males and 4 females). Of those 6 youth referrals, 6 were received from the Sterling Police Department, 0 from the parent, 0 received from school, 0 received by LCSO, and 0 received by District Court, 0 received from State Patrol.

Officers responded to 43 calls at local liquor establishments in May 2022, 0 of were a liquor code violation. 153 calls were reported in May 2021, 0 of which were liquor code violations.

K9 Glock has been phased out of active duty, as he will be retiring in the coming months. While K9 Vader completed 23 hours of training with no call outs in the month of May.

Sterling Police Officers and staff completed 265.25 hours of training during the month of May in 2022.
