A public hearing will be conducted for informing citizens and soliciting public input, written or oral, regarding the Sterling Wastewater System Improvements and Preliminary Engineering Report (PER). The PER is a report detailing the project needs consisting of improved treatment processes to meet upcoming regulations; replace deteriorating infrastructure; and expanding the existing wastewater treatment facility (WWTF) to 3.0 million gallons per day (mgd) to meet future wastewater flow based upon projected population growth for year 2040.

Project work will take place in three areas: (1) headworks, (2) force main, and (3) WWTF. The report is being submitted to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to qualify Sterling Wastewater System Improvements for a State Revolving Fund Loan. The anticipated cost of the project is \$37 million.

At the public hearing, the Project Needs Assessment (PNA) and Environmental Assessment (EA) will also be reviewed. Copies of the PER, PNA, and EA are available for public review prior to the Public Hearing. Because of the Coronavirus, the PER, PNA, and EA are available for review at www.sterlingcolo.com under the Public Works site.
