BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2015, the Talladega County Commission assembled at the Talladega County Courthouse in the Commission Courtroom, it being the first regular meeting of April, 2015. The following proceedings were had to wit:

**COMMISSION MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

Chairman Kelvin Cunningham called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. The roll was called with the following Commissioners being present: Commissioner Jackie Swinford, Commissioner Tony Haynes, Commissioner Kelvin Cunningham, Commissioner Malley Limbaugh and Commissioner Greg Atkinson. A quorum was present.

The news media was represented by The Daily Home. Judge Billy Atkinson gave the invocation.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Tony Haynes to adopt the Agenda and seconded by Commissioner Jackie Swinford. Motion carried.

**APPROVE MINUTES OF MARCH 23, 2015**

Commissioner Greg Atkinson made a motion to approve the minutes of March 23, 2015 and seconded by Commissioner Tony Haynes. Motion carried.

**REQUEST TO APPOINT BOARD MEMBER TO E-911**

Commissioner Malley Limbaugh made a motion to approve the appointment of Ken Wesson to fill the unexpired term of Don Maxwell who resigned effective March 30, 2015 due to health issues. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Greg Atkinson. Motion carried.

**REQUEST COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN WORKING AGREEMENT**

County Administrator Patricia Lyle requested Commission approval for Talladega County and its Board of Registrars to enter into a Working Agreement with the City of Talladega to provide services for a special election in Talladega. Commissioner Tony Haynes made a motion to approve and seconded by Commissioner Jackie Swinford.

**REQUEST TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN  
COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH STATE OF ALABAMA EMA**

EMA Director, Travis McGrady, requested Commission approval to enter into and the Chairman sign the EMPG State Cooperative Agreement for the grant award of \$5,134.00. There are no matching funds required. Commissioner Greg Atkinson made a motion to approve and seconded by Commissioner Tony Haynes. Motion carried.

**AGREEMENT WITH TOWN OF MUNFORD FOR ROAD REPAIRS**

County Engineer Tim Markert requested Commission approval to enter into and sign an agreement with the Town of Munford for repairs to the city portion of Deerwood Road. The Town of Munford will pay County \$12,502.65. Commissioner Jackie Swinford made a motion to approve and seconded by Commissioner Malley Limbaugh. Motion carried.

**REQUEST TO SURPLUS OLD SOUND EQUIPMENT  
FROM COMMISSIONERS' COURTROOM AND DONATE**

County Administrator Patricia Lyle requested Commission approval to surplus the courtroom's old sound equipment and donate to the Childersburg Elementary School. Commissioner Malley Limbaugh made a motion to approve and seconded by Commissioner Jackie Swinford. Motion carried.

**CONFERENCE REQUESTS AND TRAINING**

County Administrator Patricia Lyle submitted the conference requests for approval. A motion was made by Commissioner Jackie Swinford to approve and seconded by Commissioner Tony Haynes. Motion carried.

**PERSONNEL CHANGES AND REQUESTS**

County Administrator Patricia Lyle presented the personnel changes and requests for approval. A motion was made by Commissioner Greg Atkinson and seconded by Commissioner Jackie Swinford to approve. Motion carried.

**EXPENDITURES**

County Administrator Patricia Lyle presented the expenditures to the Commission for approval through April 13, 2015 in the amount of \$2,903,432 as well as the routine operating transfers. A motion was made by Commissioner Jackie Swinford to approve and seconded by Commissioner Tony Haynes. Motion carried.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**




**ANNOUNCEMENTS**

**MEETING ADJOURNED**


