BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2015, the Talladega County Commission assembled at the Talladega County Courthouse in the Commission Courtroom, it being the second regular meeting of April, 2015. The following proceedings were had to wit:

**COMMISSION MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

Chairman Kelvin Cunningham called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. The roll was called with the following Commissioners being present: Commissioner Jackie Swinford, Commissioner Tony Haynes, Commissioner Kelvin Cunningham, Commissioner Malley Limbaugh and Commissioner Greg Atkinson. A quorum was present.

The news media was represented by The Daily Home and Shoot First Video. Pastor Dante Whitaker gave the invocation.

**ADOPT AMENDED AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Greg Atkinson to remove action item B “Animal Control” and seconded by Commissioner Tony Haynes. Motion carried.

**APPROVE MINUTES OF APRIL 13, 2015**

Commissioner Tony Haynes made a motion to approve the minutes of April 13, 2015 and seconded by Commissioner Greg Atkinson. Motion carried.

**PETITION OF CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM FOR  
INDUSTRIAL PARK DESIGNATION AND SCHEDULE PUBLIC HEARING**

County Attorney Barry Vaughn presented for consideration the Petition of Corporation for the Promotion of Rifle Practice and Firearms Safety d/b/a Civilian Marksmanship Program (“CMP”) to establish certain real property owned by CMP as an industrial park to be known as CMP Talladega Marksmanship Park. Mr. Vaughn stated that before the Petition can be approved, a notice is required to be published in a local newspaper 10-days’ prior to a scheduled public hearing date. This will provide the public with the opportunity to comment or address any issues at that time. Mr. Vaughn requested

Commission approval to schedule the public hearing for Monday, May 11, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. in the Commissioners' courtroom.

Commissioner Tony Haynes made a motion to accept the petition as presented by Mr. Vaughn and schedule the public hearing for Monday, May 11, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. in the Commissioners' courtroom. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jackie Swinford. Motion carried.

### **AMENDMENT TO EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN**

EMA Director, Travis McGrady, requested the Commission approve and the Chairman to sign an Amendment to the Emergency Operations Plan with the Talladega Superspeedway. Commissioner Jackie Swinford made a motion to approve and seconded by Commissioner Malley Limbaugh. Motion carried.

### **CONFERENCE REQUESTS AND TRAINING**

County Administrator Pat Lyle submitted the conference requests for approval. A motion was made by Commissioner Jackie Swinford to approve and seconded by Commissioner Greg Atkinson. Motion carried.

### **PERSONNEL CHANGES AND REQUESTS**

County Administrator Pat Lyle presented the personnel changes and requests for approval. A motion was made by Commissioner Jackie Swinford and seconded by Commissioner Tony Haynes to approve. Motion carried.

### **BUDGET**

County Administrator Pat Lyle presented the budget for Commission approval. A motion was made by Commissioner Jackie Swinford and seconded by Commissioner Malley Limbaugh to approve. Motion carried.

### **EXPENDITURES**

County Administrator Pat Lyle presented the expenditures to the Commission for approval through April 27, 2015 in the amount of \$434,322.51 as well as the routine operating transfers. A motion was made by Commissioner Greg Atkinson to approve and seconded by Commissioner Jackie Swinford. Motion carried.

### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

A. County Animal Control – Amber Nicholson discussed the need for animal control in the County due to the rise in stray animals, safety due to fatal attacks, traffic accidents and the spread of rabies. Commissioner Greg Atkinson thanked Ms. Nicholson for attending and stated the County would gather information on how to establish a short and long-term solution to alleviate the problem.

B. Public Service Recognition Week Proclamation – Commissioner Kelvin Cunningham presented a Public Service Recognition Week Proclamation recognizing the accomplishments and contributions of government employees.




- The next Commission Work Session is scheduled for Monday, May 11, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. in the Commission conference room

- The next Commission meeting is scheduled for Monday, May 11, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Commission courtroom


**MEETING ADJOURNED**
