The Talladega County Commission assembled at the Talladega County Courthouse in the Commission Courtroom, 1 Court Square, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Talladega, Alabama, for the second meeting of the month held on June 27, 2022.

**COMMISSION MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

The commission meeting was called to order by Chairman Kelvin Cunningham at 6:08 p.m. The following commissioners were present: District 1 Commissioner Darrell Ingram, District 2 Commissioner Tony Haynes, District 3 Commissioner Kelvin Cunningham, District 4 Commissioner Malley Limbaugh, and District 5 Commissioner Phillip Morris. A quorum was established.

Commissioner Ingram gave the invocation, with the pledge of allegiance being recited by attendees. Media was represented by The Daily Home.

**APPROVE JUNE 27, 2022 AGENDA AS PRESENTED**

Commissioner Ingram made a motion to approve the agenda as a presented, with a second motion by Commissioner Haynes. Motion carried.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

- During the work session, State Representative Ben Robbins presented information about the proposed East Alabama Regional Training Hub (EARTH) project that would be located at the former Avondale Mill site in Sylacauga.
- During the work session, Michael Cruise from ADEM presented information to the Commission about programs that ADEM has to help with scrap tire removal and illegal dumping sites.

### **APPROVE MINUTES OF JUNE 13, 2022**

Commissioner Haynes made a motion to approve the minutes of June 13, 2022, with a second by Commissioner Morris. Motion carried.

### **APPROVE AGREEMENT WITH CITY OF LINCOLN RELATED TO WATER SYSTEM**

County Administrator Pat Lyle presented to the Commission for their approval an agreement with the City of Lincoln related to the water system. Commissioner Haynes made a motion to approve the agreement with the City of Lincoln related to the water system, with a second motion by Commissioner Morris. Motion carried.

### **APPROVE TABLED REQUEST FROM HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO SURPLUS VEHICLE**

County Engineer Shannon Robbins requested at the June 13, 2022 meeting to surplus a vehicle from the Highway department's inventory, but the request was tabled pending further information. The vehicle in question was donated to the Commission, but is no longer in use. Commissioner Haynes made a motion to approve the surplus request, with a second motion by Commissioner Limbaugh. Motion carried.

### **APPROVE CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT WITH COOSA VALLEY RC&D AND APPROVE NEW CONTRACT WITH BAILEY'S BUSHHOGGING**

County Engineer Shannon Robbins presented the Commission with a request to cancel a previously approved contract with Coosa Valley RC&D for the mowing of the County's watersheds. He informed the Commission that Coosa Valley RC&D does not have anyone on staff who is able to mow the watersheds. He requested that the Commission approve a new yearly contract submitted by Bailey's Bushhogging for the mowing of the County's watersheds. Commissioner Haynes made a motion to approve the cancellation of the contract with Coosa Valley RC&D and the signing of a new one-year contract with Bailey's Bushhogging for the mowing of the County's watersheds, with a second motion by Commissioner Ingram. Motion carried.

### **APPROVE EXPENDITURES**

County Administrator Pat Lyle submitted the expenditures in the amount of \$416,998.74 for Commission approval. Commissioner Haynes made a motion to approve the expenditures, with a second motion by Commissioner Morris. Motion carried.


**ANNOUNCEMENTS**
