**4-A. (FORMERLY ITEM NO. 16) THE BOARD TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE TAYLOR COUNTY BASEBALL ASSOCIATION, INC., TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROVISION AND REGULATION OF PARENT-RUN BASEBALL.**

**SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:**

THE TAYLOR COUNTY BASEBALL ASSOCIATION HAS PROVIDED THE TAYLOR COUNTY RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD (TCRAB) AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, A DRAFT MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) THAT DETAILS A THREE (3) YEAR TRANSITION OF A COUNTY RECREATION BASEBALL PROGRAM TO A PARENT-RUN BASEBALL PROGRAM. THE TCRAB VOTED DURING THEIR JUNE MEETING TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE REQUEST.

THE MOU ALLOWS FOR A 3 YEAR PHASED TRANSITION WHICH DETAILS AN ANNUAL ASSUMPTION OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY BY THE TAYLOR COUNTY BASEBALL ASSOCIATION. BY THE THIRD YEAR, THE LEAGUE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR UNIFORMS, INSURANCE, TROPHIES, GATE FEES AND CONCESSIONS. BY THE THIRD YEAR, THE LEAGUE WILL ALSO RETAIN PROFITS FROM CONCESSIONS AND GATE FEES.
