THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TAYLOR COUNTY, FLORIDA, MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON THE ABOVE DATE.

PRESENT WERE PAM FEAGLE, CHAIRMAN, MALCOLM PAGE, JIM MOODY, SEAN MURPHY AND THOMAS DEMPS, A FULL BOARD BEING PRESENT. COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, LAWANDA PEMBERTON, ASSISTANT COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, MARSHA DURDEN, DEPUTY CLERK OF COURT, GARY KNOWLES AND COUNTY FINANCE DIRECTOR, DANNIELLE WELCH WERE ALSO PRESENT.

THOMAS DEMPS LED THE BOARD IN PRAYER, FOLLOWED BY PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG. THE BOARD WAS THEN CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN FEAGLE, AND BUSINESS TRANSACTED AS FOLLOWS:

UPON MOTION OF COMMISSIONER DEMPS, WITH SECOND BY COMMISSIONER MURPHY, AND BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, THE BOARD AMENDED THE AGENDA FOR THIS DATE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. ADD AS ITEM NO. 5., THE BOARD TO DISCUSS GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER CONCERNING MEETING BY TELECONFERENCE.
4. THE BOARD DISCUSSED SETTING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATES AND BUDGET IN THE GENERAL REVENUE AND THE M.S.T.U. FUNDS FOR FY 2020-2021.

AFTER DISCUSSION AND UPON MOTION OF COMMISSIONER PAGE, WITH SECOND BY COMMISSIONER MOODY, AND BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, THE BOARD SET THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 7.2426 IN THE GENERAL FUND FOR FY 2020-2021.

UPON MOTION OF COMMISSIONER DEMPS, WITH SECOND BY COMMISSIONER MURPHY, AND BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, THE BOARD SET THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 1.2250 IN THE M.S.T.U. FUND FOR FY 2020-2021.

TOTAL MILLAGE RATE IN THE GENERAL REVENUE FUND AND THE M.S.T.U. FUND OF 8.4676.

THE COUNTY FINANCE DIRECTOR ADVISED THE BOARD OF BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING DATES FOR FY 2020-2021, AS FOLLOWS:

- TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2020 5:01 P.M.
- MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2020 5:01 P.M.

THAT THE PROPOSED BUDGET WILL BE ADVERTISED IN THE FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2020 EDITION OF THE PERRY NEWSPAPER.

5. THE BOARD TO DISCUSS GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER CONCERNING MEETINGS BY TELECONFERENCE.

THE BOARD WAS ADVISED THAT THE TELECONFERENCE ORDER WILL EXPIRE AUGUST 1. THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR QUESTIONED HOW THE BOARD WISHES TO PROCEED, AS THERE IS A SURGEON GENERAL'S ADVISORY TO WARN AGAINST GROUPS OF GREATER THAN TEN (10).

COMMISSIONER MURPHY STATED THAT AS THIS IS A MATTER OF PUBLIC SAFETY, HE WOULD LIKE TO LEAVE THE MEETINGS AS TELECONFERENCE, AS THE PUBLIC HAS MORE ACCESS THROUGH TELECONFERENCE, AS ANYONE CAN CALL IN. IT WAS A CONSENSUS OF THE BOARD TO LEAVE THEIR MEETINGS AS TELECONFERENCE FOR THE TIME BEING.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, AND UPON MOTION OF COMMISSIONER
DEMPS, WITH SECOND BY COMMISSIONER MURPHY, AND BY UNANIMOUS VOTE,
THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED.
