

VOLUNTARY EVACUATION ORDER

TAYLOR COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TAYLOR COUNTY, FLORIDA ORDERING THE IMMEDIATE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VOLUNTARY EVACUATION OF RV RESIDENTS AND MOBILE HOMES AND COASTAL AND LOW-LYING AREAS OF THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, HURRICANE IRMA may threaten the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Taylor County and may require expedient actions to be taken to implement emergency protective measures; and

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Board of County Commissioners have declared a Local State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, Taylor County is potentially within the tropical storm winds according to the National Hurricane Center reports;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Taylor County, Florida as follows:

SECTION I


A Voluntary Evacuation is ordered for residents of the Taylor County residents with RV and mobile homes, coastal and those low-lying areas.
