A special meeting of the Tinley Park Police Pension Board was called to order at 6:00p.m. by President Violetto. The following were:

PRESENT: President Violetto, Trustee Carl Lindokken, Trustee John Chomiak, Trustee Tim Ehlers and Trustee Frederick Mondt (participating via telephone)

President Violetto asked for a motion to consider a pension for Detective Raymond Violetto. Detective Violetto is a tier 1 officer, age 60, with 32 years of service and a retirement date of 11/30/2021. He will receive 75% of this final pensionable salary of \$116,499.41, as based on the current union contract. He will receive an initial monthly benefit of \$7281.21.

Trustee Ehlers moved the motion and Trustee Chomiak seconded the motion.

A roll call vote was conducted:

AYES: Trustee Violetto, Trustee Lindokken, Trustee Chomiak, Trustee Ehlers, and Trustee Mondt

NAYS: None

President Violetto declared the motion carried.

President Violetto advised the board was in receipt of a disability application for Officer Roger Davisson. President Violetto advised that subpoenas were issued for medical records and the board was awaiting receipt of those records.

President Violetto advised the pension board attorney agenda item would be tabled for a future meeting.

President Violetto advised the fund had received a new applicant. President Violetto advised that Deputy Chief Thomas Tilton is age 59 and married and he would be a tier 2 member. President Violetto advised that Tilton had a hire date of 09/24/2021 and received his certification as a police officer within the past month from the Illinois Law Enforcement Trainings and Standards Board.

Trustee Lindokken moved and Trustee Chomiak seconded the motion. A roll call vote was conducted:

AYES: Trustee Violetto, Trustee Lindokken, Trustee Chomiak, Trustee Ehlers, and Trustee Mondt

NAYS: None

President Violetto declared the motion carried.

President Violetto advised the IPOPIF resolution would be tabled for a future meeting.

There was no executive session.

There was no member of the public wanting to make a comment.

President Violetto asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:05p.m. Trustee Ehlers moved and Trustee Chomiak seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously by voice vote.
