The purpose of this executive session was to consider probably and imminent litigation and land acquisition. It has been made clear that Orland Hills intends to annex an 11.5 acre parcel located at the southeast corner of 171st and 96th Avenue. Tinley Park will be pro-active in opposing this annexation to protect the interest of our citizens that border two of the three sides of this parcel.

This site was planned to be in the Village of Tinley Park and annexation of this parcel by Orland Hills would represent the worst of planning.

Additionally, if this annexation were to take place, it was agreed that we may be compelled to put Citizens Utilities on notice that services in the area of Orland Hills may be disconnected from lake water and the ultimate effects would place Orland Hills residents back on water provided by wells.
