

Love is Harmony event coming this weekend

Tinley Park Mayor Jacob Vandenberg will host a series of events called “Love is Harmony” from Sept. 7 to 9 in conjunction with the Tinley Park/Orland Hills Ministerial Association, the Tinley Park Park District, the Tinley Park Public Library and the Village of Tinley Park.

During the event, participants will be able to craft unique flags that will be displayed around the Village. While the program is inspired by the traditional Tibetan prayer flag, residents can include any message they want, so long as it is one of love and acceptance.

“In today’s America, it can seem like we’re becoming more divisive and less connected to our neighbors and communities,” Vandenberg said. “This event was created in direct response to that divineness and disconnection and is an opportunity for us to get together and show that Tinley Park is a community built on love, mutual respect, togetherness and harmony.”

Crafting stations will be available from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Friday, Sept. 7 at the Bettenhausen Recreation Center, 8125 W. 171st St; 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 8 at Tinley Park Public Library, 7851 Timber Drive; and 7 to 9:30 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 8 at the Village’s Music in the Plaza concert in Zabrocki Plaza, 17375 S. Oak Park Ave. More crafting stations will be available Sunday, Sept. 9 at various houses of worship across the Village.
