

Village lifts mask mandate

In accordance with CDC and State of Illinois guidelines, the Village of Tinley Park has lifted the mask mandate it imposed last year to help contain the spread of COVID-19. Tinley Park residents who have been fully vaccinated are no longer required to wear a face covering in most situations. Masks are still required under certain conditions.

Individuals are considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving either the two-dose series from Pfizer or Moderna, or the single-shot of the Johnson and Johnson vaccine. The Village will rely on the State of Illinois' Executive Order 2021-10 - Bridge Phase for guidance concerning general mask use by the public.

All federal, state and regional public health metrics and associated guidance will continue to be monitored moving forward. The Village will review the resulting COVID-19 response protocols from these authorities and implement future public health recommendations as appropriate.
