

## **Village to enact Christmas House traffic measures**

In order to ensure everyone visiting the Winter Wonderland display at 17321 Avon Lane has a safe experience that is respectful to residents in the surrounding neighborhood, the Village of Tinley Park will enact several traffic measures beginning Thursday, Dec. 2.

The display will be open from 5 to 10 p.m. daily. Incoming and nonresidential traffic will be shut down at 9 p.m. to allow an hour for the neighborhood to clear of visitors. The following streets will be closed to nonresidential traffic by 4 p.m. each day:

- Avon Lane
- Dee Court
- Trent Court
- Tamar Lane
- Humbert Lane from Carriage Lane to Raintree Road
- Derwent Lane
- Witham Court

Parking will be prohibited on either side of the street at 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 171<sup>st</sup> 175<sup>th</sup> streets; on Humbert Lane; on Raintree Road from 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Humbert Lane; on Chestnut Drive; on Locust Avenue from Juniper Court to Chestnut Drive; and on 174<sup>th</sup> Street from Chestnut Drive to 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Parking on the non-fire hydrant side of the street will be allowed on Carriage Lane and Valley Drive.

The Village also has erected six electronic message boards at key locations to let visitors know how long the wait will be to see the exhibit and where to park, if available. Tinley police have a plan in place when traffic increases and are working with Prairie View School to provide for additional parking. The Village is also working with the property owner to ensure trash left by visitors is picked up every day. The Public Works Department also has provided trash cans around the area.
