Tracy Curtis, Community Education & Outreach Coordinator for the South Suburban Crisis Center, will be at the Community Center to discuss Domestic Violence in Later Life. Her presentation discusses the difference between elder abuse and domestic violence in later life and who can be targets of being victimized. Also discussed will be the barriers for why victimized individuals do not seek help and how ageism impacts the way domestic violence in later life is addressed. Lastly, information will be discussed on how to both prevent and/or respond to domestic violence in later life.
