The Town Clerk's office is now accepting Absentee Ballot Requests for the upcoming June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Municipal & School Budget election.

Absentee ballot requests may be in writing, by phone, online, or in person. However; if you are asking to receive your ballot by mail, please request it early enough to allow for postal mail delivery time – both to receive it and return it (at least 4-5 days each way).

- You can request an absentee ballot by calling your Municipal Clerk's office at **207-247-6166**; each person requesting needs to speak to the clerk personally.
- Printed ballots will be available by the second week of May. Once received, requested ballots will be issued as soon as possible.
- We recommend returning ballots as soon as possible, preferably by Thursday June 08<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- There will be NO Absentee Voting on Friday June 09<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and Monday June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- Ballots **MUST** be returned to the municipal clerk no later than 8:00 pm on Election Day.
