



FLEET MAINTENANCE






Central Garage services include maintaining over 560 assets the City of Waterloo utilizes to perform daily tasks. The assets range from small engines, such as chain saws, to large grinders generating 600 HP.



A more thorough pre/post trip inspection form for city vehicles was implemented, resulting in finding minor repairs before becoming more costly and decreasing the down time of equipment.







Central garage, with the assistance of the street department, updated the equipment in snow trucks to maximize efficiency of snow removal events.


