➤ **FY 2021 SHAULIS ROAD RECONSTRUCTION – HESS ROAD TO US-218, Contract No. 1020**

E. Shaulis Road is closed from the Lost Island Themepark entrance to the Isle Casino entrance. This closure will be in place until June 8. Beginning June 8, closure will begin of the Shaulis Rd./La Porte Rd intersection. Access to the Isle Casino, Lost Island Waterpark, and Lost Island Themepark will only be from Hwy 218.

➤ **400 BLOCK OF LOMA STREET CLOSURE**

The 400 block of Loma Street is closed to allow sewer maintenance staff to perform sanitary sewer repairs. The approximate location of this closure is at 464/465 Loma Street so the street will be accessible to local traffic only, no thru traffic. Closure is expected to be in place for approximately one week.

➤ **FY 2023 E. SAN MARNAN DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT , Contract No. 1084**

Stage I of the E. San Marnan Drive Reconstruction project is currently under construction in the southwestern quadrant of the E. San Marnan Drive/Hawkeye Road (Hwy 21) intersection.

During this stage of construction, the following will apply:

- Eastbound E. San Marnan Drive traffic will not be allowed right turns onto southbound Hawkeye Road.
- Westbound E. San Marnan Drive traffic will not be allowed left turns onto southbound Hawkeye Road.
- Northbound Hawkeye Road traffic will not be allowed left turns onto westbound E. San Marnan Drive.

**E. 4<sup>TH</sup> STREET CLOSURE – RALSTON RD. TO LAKESIDE ST.**

E. 4<sup>th</sup> Street from Ralston Rd. to Lakeside St. is closed for construction.

➤ **W. 9<sup>TH</sup> STREET AND SOUTH STREET MINI-ROUNDAABOUT**

The W. 9<sup>th</sup> Street and South Street intersection is closed to allow the contractor to perform work related to the above-mentioned project. There is a signed detour in place. ➤ **FY 2022 PARK AVENUE & 11<sup>TH</sup> STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT, Contract No. 1013**

**11<sup>TH</sup> STREET BRIDGE**

The 11<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge is closed. A signed detour is in place. Access will be maintained to all local businesses. The bridge is expected to reopen late fall of 2023.

**PARK AVENUE BRIDGE**

The Park Avenue Bridge is closed. Closures and detours related to bridge demolition and construction are expected to remain in place until Fall 2023. E. Park Avenue is closed at the north end of the bridge. The 100 block of W. Park Ave. (bridge to Sycamore St.) is open to local traffic only but will be closed to traffic later this year for bridge and street construction. W. Park Avenue is closed from Commercial Street to the bridge. Both Cedar Streets are closed at W. Park Avenue. **Motorists and pedestrians are not to move the barricades and access the closed area.**

➤ **HAMMOND AVENUE BRIDGE OVER SINK CREEK CLOSURE**

The Hammond Avenue Bridge over Sink Creek, south of Orange Rd., remains closed indefinitely due to safety concerns. The City currently has a consulting engineering firm under contract for design to replace the bridge.
