

**Minutes of The
City of Waterloo Complete Streets Advisory Committee Meeting
May 30, 2023**

The Meeting of the City of Waterloo Complete Streets Advisory Committee was called to order at 1:30 pm April 25, 2023, by Vice-Chairperson Durant in the Mollenhoff Conference Room at Waterloo City Hall.

Roll Call: Members present: Jessica Rucker, Paul Huting, John Dornoff, Kyle Durant, David Sturch, Wayne Castle representing Oumie Ceesay, and Aric Schroeder.

Members absent were: Felicia Cass, Kathryn Gilbery, Dwight Diercks, Ray Feuss, and Greg Young.

Other attendees: Doug Schindel and Michelle Sweeney – AECOM, Nick Frantze – INRCOG, and Curtis Young.

It was moved by Rucker and seconded by Castle to approve the minutes of the April 25, 2023, meeting, amending the minutes to show Rucker present at the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Agenda Items:

1. Traffic Department Report

- Durant goes over the benefits of bike lanes.
- Looked at the Park Avenue corridor from South Street to East 4th Street/
- Change would put parking along curbs and bike lanes between parking and the street.
- The bike lanes are 5' wide.
- Green bike lanes are shown but not required.
- City will probably not do anything more than is doing now when it comes to markings.
- Durant also showed bike boxes at major intersections, but it was questioned if they were necessary.
- There would be some buffer between the bike lanes and the traffic.
- Currently showing a right turn lane from westbound Park Avenue to northbound Commercial Street but could be additional parking.
- Diercks had provided comments to Durant about the changes.
- Durant also showed what bike lanes along Commercial Street would look like and provide a connection through the west side commercial district.
- The driveway from Bergen will be removed as part of the Park Avenue Bridge project.
- Discussion of removing parking spaces in front of the parking garage at Lafayette.
- Question of whether a right turn lane is also necessary from Park Avenue to Mulberry in front of the Elks Club.
- There are bike route signs and sharrows on Park Avenue from Franklin to Walnut.
- Durant showed possible bike lanes along 4th Avenue.
- Possible funding sources from INRCOG.

It was moved by Rucker and seconded by Castle to recommend to design the Park Avenue Bike Lanes, and all future on road bike lane projects, to include on street bicycle lanes in between the travel lane and parking against the curb. Motion carried unanimously.

- The docks for the marina project should be installed next year.


