

**Minutes of The
City of Waterloo Complete Streets Advisory Committee Meeting
June 29, 2021**

Meeting of the City of Waterloo Complete Streets Advisory Committee was called to order at 1:31pm June 29, 2021 by Chairperson Cass in the Harold E. Getty Council Chambers, City Hall.

It was moved by Schroeder, seconded by Schoon to approve the minutes of the May 25, 2021 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Codie Leseman has accepted a new job offer and is leaving the area so there will need to be a new member and new Vice-Chairman.

1. Update on Waterloo Pedestrian Plan and Overlay/Recon Review and Recommendations

- Castle has added more features to the map.
- Waiting for census data to come in.

2. Scooter Update

- They have been launched.

3. RAGBRAI Update

- Preparations underway.
- Campground and entertainment going well.
- Unplanned Sargent road trail east of Fletcher is closed to issues with age of bridges and will probably will be closed until next year. RAGBRAI will detour will have to detour on Fletcher to the University Avenue trail.
- Cass concerned about drivers that have had drink and bikers that may have had drinks mixing on Fletcher could be a concern.
- However, that section will only be needed for campers.
- One block of Park Avenue in front of Elks Club has been painted green in the bike lanes.

4. Upcoming Planning Commission Agenda Review

- Schroeder will send out a review.
- Cass asked if the committee should vote to recommend sidewalks.
- Castle stated that looking at internal connections should on the North Crossing property.
- New Viridian Credit Union at former Burger King at San Marnan and Kimball Avenue.
- Should sidewalks be required on Nicki and Tower Park?

Motion made by Castle seconded by Kofta to encourage sidewalks both along street frontages and internal connections to the rest of the North Crossing development.

Motion made by Schoon, seconded by Kofta to recommend sidewalks on Nicki Street and Tower Park Drive.

5. La Porte Road Update

- AECOM is finishing up the corridor study on the project and now working on final design contract for the Hess Road portion.
- Looking at a Raise grant to cover portion of construction (former Tiger grant).
- Some preliminary designs should be ready this winter.

6. Other Project Status Updates

- Cedar Valley Nature trail to Cedar Terrace is under construction.
- This summer the portion from Isle of Capri to US 218.
- Working to get University Avenue completed from Fletcher to US Highway 63 completed by RAIGBRAI.
- New monuments should be shortly.
- Plantings should be done shortly in phase 2.
- US Highway 63 final trail project between Newell and Parker under construction.
- Cass about connections from Park Avenue to University Avenue which would be responsibility of the traffic department.
- Castle had meetings with IowaDOT to get bridges project going with letting in September.
- Cass asked about delineators on Park Avenue which have been present the last couple of years but no there now.
- Infill projects should be done this summer.
