WATERLOO HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING – 4:30 P.M. JANUARY 15, 2002

Chairperson Levi called the regular meeting of the Waterloo Historic Preservation Commission to order at 4:45 p.m.

Members present were: Aronson, Leonhart, Levi, and Etheredge. Also present were Terry Poe Buschkamp with MainStreet Waterloo and staff members Noel Anderson and Melissa Edsill.

Buschkamp presented the MainStreet report as the Commission awaited a quorum. Buschkamp reported to the Commission the status of the Regional Business Center, March Place Apartments, and upcoming activities. She also stated that the historic inventory data of the commercial properties within the Self Supported Municipal Improvement District (SSMID) were available on their website. Buschkamp continued by telling the Commission that this fall there would be a “This Old House” tour instead of the “D’Tour” as was held previously, and invited the Commission to attend.

The Commission briefly discussed updating the City of Waterloo’s historic site inventory and ways they could fund that. The Commission directed Staff to research what grants were available for funding.

Without having a quorum, no business from the agenda was discussed and the meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
